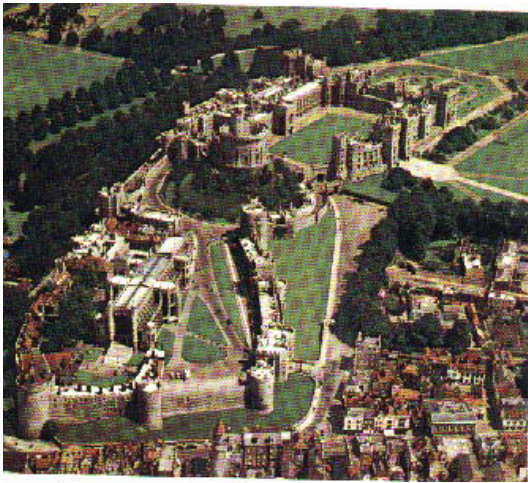

## Romanticism



### Windsor Castle

The largest castle in England. Standing on a hill of chalk near the Thames, it was originally built to guard London's approaches. The castle has grown continuously since it was established by William the Conqueror. Edward III considerably enlarged the Royal apartments in Upper Ward, and founded St George's Chapel. An immense amount of restoration and embellishment was undertaken under George III, George IV and Victoria, and much of what is seen today is the creation of this period - the great Round Tower as built by Henry II was much lower and many towers in Upper Ward were built or heightened during the Gothic restorations by Sir Jeffry Wyattville in the early 19th century.
